This year, we've loved reaching new audiences across the region by working with our local libraries.

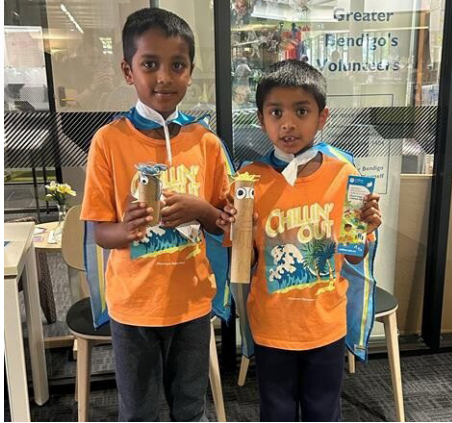

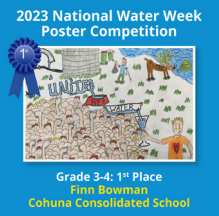

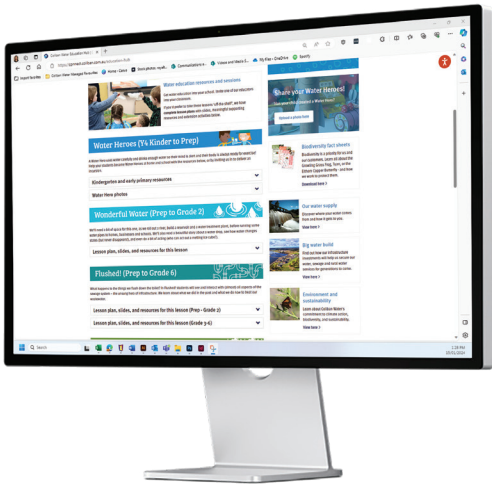
